Standardised taxi fares in Budapest

All taxis accept bankcards. Fares valid until 1 July 2018.

Base fare + HUF/km + HUF/min (under 15 km/h) 700 HUF 300 HUF 75 HUF







Tickets and travelcards



The *single ticket* is valid only for one trip on a single line without interruption, on the full length of the route. Transfers between the metro lines are possible with the ticket.

With the *transfer ticket*, you can change to another service once. Validate ticket number 1 for the first vehicle and ticket number 2 after you transfer.



Up to five passengers travelling together may use the group travelcard.

Special fares apply to boats, bus line 100E, services leaving Budapest as well as to heritage transport vehicles. For a full list of travel products, terms and conditions of free and discounted travel please visit **bkk.hu**

Where to get your ticket



Ticket vending machines

Tickets and passes every day, round the clock with cash or bankcard.

BKK Customer Service Centres

Maps and brochures are also available. Cash and bankcards are accepted.

On board

Only single ticket for a higher price. Please have the exact amount ready as the driver does not have change.

Always validate your ticket

You must validate your ticket as soon as you board. On the metro network, stamp your ticket with the validating machine before you enter the station. No need to validate travelcards or passes.

Validate your ticket at the beginning of your trip
To use the old-style, manual validator, insert your
ticket into the opening on top and punch it by
pulling the black frame of the slot towards you.
Keep your ticket until the end of your trip.
Inspectors will issue a penalty fare to you if you
travel without a validated ticket. You can pay in cash
on the spot or you can also pay with a bankcard
at designated customer service centres. Please check

Night transport



Travel with transfer ticket or a travelcard or a pass.

The typical taxi fare between the airport and the city (21 km) is 7 600 HUF (ca. 24 EUR) depending on traffic.

MOL Bubi public bike system

The MOL Bubi public bike system is an environmentally friendly public transport mode ideal for short rides to explore the city on two wheels. The first 30 minutes of each trip are free with a ticket.









Join

Buy a ticket at one of the selected docking stations.

Pickup

Use your phone number and 6-digit code (sent by SMS) to unlock a bike.



Ride





Take as many short rides (up to 30 minutes each) as you want.





Return

Return the bike to any docking station and lock it.





MOL Bubi Weekly ticket 2 000 HUF When buying a ticket, a deposit of 25 000 HUF per bike will be temporarily blocked in your bank account. Please check **molbubi.bkk.hu** for fares and more information on the terms of use.



Up to 30 minutes free for each trip

MOL Bubi is for short rides. For over 30 minutes continously, usage fees apply and will increase with time.








Explore Budapest withHeritage Transport Services!

Travel on board the Duna Heritage Tram on Saturdays and the Thermal Heritage Tram on Sundays. Take a river ride on the Danube on board the Snow White vintage boat on Saturdays or travel on board the Bus Heritage on every second Sunday of each month.











Budapest differently





Underground railway

The first underground railway on continental Europe; in operation since 1896.

Danube heritage tram

Travels on the Danube embankment on the Pest side on Saturdays.





Link between the Royal Castle and the riverbank since 1870.









Bus heritage

Runs on a circle route every second Sunday of each month.



Chairlift

Weather permitting, the cableway carries passengers to János Hill, the highest point in Buda. Information by phone: +36 1 391 0352.







Thermal heritage tram

Operates on Sundays on a circle route linking several thermal baths in Buda.







Public transport and heritage transport boats services

Timetables depend on weather conditions. Check the BKK FUTÁR trip planner app.

Heritage transport services operate from May to October. For more information, please go to **bkk.hu/nosztalgia/**

In case of all services listed above, with the exception of metro line M1, special fares apply.





Underground Railway Museum

In the Deák Ferenc tér metro station underpass, inside the BKK Customer Service Centre. Closed on Mondays.



Urban Public Transport Museum

In the quaint town of Szentendre, next to the final station of suburban railway line H5. Open from April to October, closed on Mondays.



Transport rules



Please be polite and attentive to other passengers. If you experience a problem, notify BKK Customer Service by e-mail or telephone.



The major part of the transport network is served by low-floor vehicles. Metro line M4 is fully accessible. Plan your barrier-free journey with the BKK FUTÁR app.



The front-door boarding only policy applies on most bus lines. Show your validated ticket, your valid pass or travel ID to the driver.



Where you see a button next to a vehicle's door, push the button to open the door.



On most vehicles, signal your wish to disembark well in advance by pushing the button near the door. Please use the rear doors to exit.



Please do not approach the platform edge at metro stations until the passengers from the arriving train have exited.



Small pets and dogs in a carry-box travel free. Otherwise, leashed dogs require a muzzle and an extra ticket or pass.



You may carry a bike with you on designated bus and tram lines as well as on the suburban and cogwheel railways and boat lines. The bike requires a ticket. Please check **bkk.hu** for details.





Smoking is strictly prohibited aboard vehicles and at stops. It is also prohibited to consume food or beverages on board and at metro stations.
